


TOURISM YOUTH SUMMER CAMP

Signed No Objection Letter



Confirmation of your Availability for the Full Programme Duration

It is mandatory for participants to sign the No Objection Letter, as it confirms the following:

- Agreeing to work in a mixed environment and participate in organised field trips.
- Confirmation that the parents agree to the participation.
- Agreeing to take full responsibility for your attendance and punctuality.
- Permission to use the participant's personal photo and/or information related to their experience in the programme.
- The participant's Emergency Contact Details.

Transportation



Participants must secure their own means of getting to and from the Tourism Youth Summer Camp. Daily transportation is not provided.


