


Khebraty Programme Hospitality Industry Part-Time Jobs





About the Programme

Khebraty Programme, offered by the Department of Culture and Tourism - Abu Dhabi (DCT Abu Dhabi), introduces students to Abu Dhabi's dynamic tourism and cultural landscape. As a participant, you'll gain hands-on experience working part-time in one of the emirate's leading hotels, providing insight into the tourism industry and its role in the UAE's growth. Through the programme, you'll receive training on key aspects of tourism and culture, while understanding their vital contribution to the country's economic diversification.



Programme Duration

A two-year contract for part-time work with one of the leading hotels in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.



Programme Benefits

- ★ Eligible for Nafis Allowance, offering additional financial support and career development incentives
- Flexible working hours (4 hours per day, scheduled around your academic commitments)
- Monthly salary of AED 5,000
- All Khebraty participants will be registered under a pension scheme.



Programme Eligibility Criteria

- UAE nationals
- Aged 18 to 25
- Active university or college student
- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Able to commit to working at least 4 hours per day, 5 days a week



Programme Selection Process

The selection process, led by the Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation team, is guided by clear, transparent, and fair criteria. Below is an overview of the candidate journey through the programme:

Application

The Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation team actively promotes sector programmes and initiatives through career fairs and school talks held throughout the year. These engagements include detailed briefings on the Khebraty /me and guidance on the registration process.

Applications for Khebraty Programme open annually on August 1 and close on 31 October.

Note: Application link will be active only between 1 Aug to 31 Oct.

Required Documents (to be uploaded with your application):

1. Emirates ID
2. Updated CV
3. Updated university transcript

Shortlisting Interviews

The interview phase will begin in November/December. Candidates will receive an email from the Emiratisation team confirming the date, time, and location of their interview. If you don't see the email in your inbox, please check your spam or junk folder.

Final Selection

Following the interviews conducted by the Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation team to confirm the shortlisted candidates, a second round of interviews will then be held with the hotel establishments for the shortlisted candidates by the beginning of the year.
