- GPA 3.0+ (if in university), or 85%+ (if in high school)


Other Required Information



 Students will be placed at one of the prestigious hotels (4-5 stars hotel) for one-week job rotation



Applicants need to submit a letter of no objection from the head of family to participate in the camp.



The camp is conducted in English and Arabic, and you may be interviewed for selection to attend the camp.

Registration

The Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation team conducts career fairs and school talks throughout the year where they promote sector programmes and initiatives. This includes briefings about the **Tourism Youth Sammer Camp Programme** and sharing the steps for registration.


You will see all programmes related to our section. Click on "Tourism Youth Summer Camp Programme".

Once submitted, your application will be reviewed by our team, and we will reach out to you **2-3 months** before the start of the programme.




Screening

You should expect a call from our team members by **June** to validate the information you have shared with us. They may also ask you some additional questions to confirm that you're the best fit for the next rounds of the selection phase.


Interviews

By June you should expect an email from info@sparkhire.com. If you don't receive anything in your inbox, to check your spam/junk email folder as it might appear there.



Please read the message from DCT Abu Dhabi contained in the email.

Lastly, click "view and accept interview invitation".



Refer to the deadline stated in the email and make sure you complete the interview before the mentioned date and time.

Final Selection

- Interviews will be conducted by the Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation team to confirm the shortlisted candidates.
- For the shortlisted candidates, second interviews will then be held with the hotel or resort establishment.

Required Documents

Accepted candidates will be receiving an email requesting them to share personal documents such as:



Emirates ID



Signed No Objection Letter



Confirmation on your Availability for the Full Programme Duration

The No Objection Letter, is mandatory to be signed by you as it will require you to share the following details:

- Acceptance on working in a mixed environment and participate in organized filed trips.
- Confirmation from your parents on your participation.
- Agreement on taking the full Responsibility of your attendance and punctuality.
- Confirmation on using your personal photo and/or information related to your experience in the programme.
- Confirmation on the Emergency Contact Details.

Transportation

You will be required to come using your own private car.

During the field trips, Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation Team members will ensure providing buses from the hotel to the touristic/cultural attractions and returning you back to the same picking spot (the hotel). This will only be during the programme agenda.

The team will be giving you a capstone project to work at. The Strategic Workforce & Emiratisation team member will be briefing you on this project on the first week. You will be divided into groups to work on this project. Make sure that the Criteria will be assessed as follows:

- Brief Introduction about the team-members
- Defining the Issue/Matter
- Enablers you are using to make this project happen/problem resolved successfully:
 - Technology
 - **Polices**
 - **Human Resources**
 - Infrastructure

- you're looking into
- Moonshot Vision: Try to capture how would your proposal look like in a creative way. Remember, always make it unique and memorable!
- Requirements: what are the requirements you will take into consideration when looking to this matter/problem?
 - Benchmarking
 - Researches and Analysis (surveys/questionaries)
 - Others

Remember

- All team-members are required to speak out
- Take videos / role play / draw and engage with everyone

Graduation Day

Graduation day details, including date and time, will be shared with you one week prior to the event. The programme will include:

- Final project presentation by students in front of a judging panel.
- Announcement of the winning team
- Appreciation for all industry partner participants (the hotels).
- Students who successfully complete the programme will receive certificates at the end of the programme as well as prizes for their participation.

All participants who are within the below criteria will be given the priority to be interviewed by the Hospitality field for an opportunity to work as a part-timers in "Khebraty Programmes".

If you are within the below criteria, then congratulations for reserving your seat to be interviewed for a final interview by the industry partners and skip preassessments required.
