November 2018 DCT ABU DHABI NEWS

Department of Culture and Tourism –Abu Dhabi coordinates F1 weekend activities: More than 60,000 race fans converged on the UAE capital for the Formula 1 Etihad Airways Abu Dhabi Grand Prix, which ran from 23rd to 25th November. DCT Abu Dhabi provided an overview of the festivities, so visitors and residents were aware of the entertainment opportunities available to them during the Grand Prix weekend.

Record numbers attend Department of Culture and Tourism – Abu Dhabi's education programme: An education Programme, held as part of the 5th Traditional Handicrafts Festival and organised by DCT Abu Dhabi, saw a record 19,000 participants attend the event at the Al Qattara Arts Centre in Al Ain in November. The festival featured a wide variety of activities and cultural events including falconry, handicrafts and traditional music performances.



Spirit of the Union celebrated by DCT Abu Dhabi: Abu Dhabi marked the 47th anniversary of the founding of the UAE with a diverse series of events, promotions, and cultural activities across the emirate. Organised by DCT Abu Dhabi and in partnership with key government and private partners, the activities included a visual show at Zayed Sports City Stadium to honour the life and achievements of the UAE's Founding Father, the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, whose centennial birth year coincides with the 47th anniversary of the UAE's union.

There were also fireworks displays across the emirate, including one on Abu Dhabi's Corniche, where spectators were able to witness a spectacular show that drew 'UAE 47' over the water and across Abu Dhabi's skyline.

Other notable events included the Sheikh Zayed Heritage Festival, which started at Al Wathba on 30th November and will run until 26th January, 2019.



Department of Culture and Tourism – Abu Dhabi celebrates 10th Abu Dhabi

Art: The capital welcomed art aficionados from around the world for the 10th edition of Abu Dhabi Art, organised by DCT Abu Dhabi. The fair included a multitude of exhibitions, art installations, community events, talks, performances and exceptional artwork from 19 countries from across the globe. This year Abu Dhabi Art also reflected on the vision and values of Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the Founding Father of the UAE, in commemoration of the 'Year of Zayed'; namely tolerance, openness, community investment and cultural dialogue.

The event provided an important sales platform for participating galleries whilst also offering these galleries an opportunity to showcase ambitious installations and site specific works by their artists to an audience of more than 20,000 visitors. The event also offered workshops for different age groups including masterclasses with experts.

8	Available rooms for sale	Number of rooms available during the month covered by the report excluding out-of-order (a room status term indicating that a room is scheduled for maintenance, refurbishment, deep cleaning, etc.)
P	Occupied rooms	Number of rooms used on a daily basis including complimentary rooms.
	Occupancy Rate, %	Occupancy is the percentage of available rooms that are occupied, calculated by dividing the number of occupied rooms by the available rooms.
	Hotel Guests	Number of guests staying in the hotel including those who occupied complimentary or non-revenue generating rooms either for day-stay or overnight-stay.
9	Guests Nights	Number of night guests spent in the hotel regardless of the type of rooms they occupy.
	Average Length of Stay (ALOS)	Average number of nights guests spent in a single stay, calculated by dividing guest nights by hotel guests.
Ø	Total revenues	Revenue generated by hotels from all their operations, including service charge and taxes.
۲	Average room (daily) rate ARR/ADR	A ratio that indicates average room rate and to what extent rooms are being up-sold or discounted; calculated by dividing room revenue by the number of occupied rooms. (excludes complimentary & house use)
3	Revenue per available room <i>RevPAR</i>	Revenue per Available rooms, calculated by dividing the total revenues by total rooms in hotel minus out-of-service rooms
